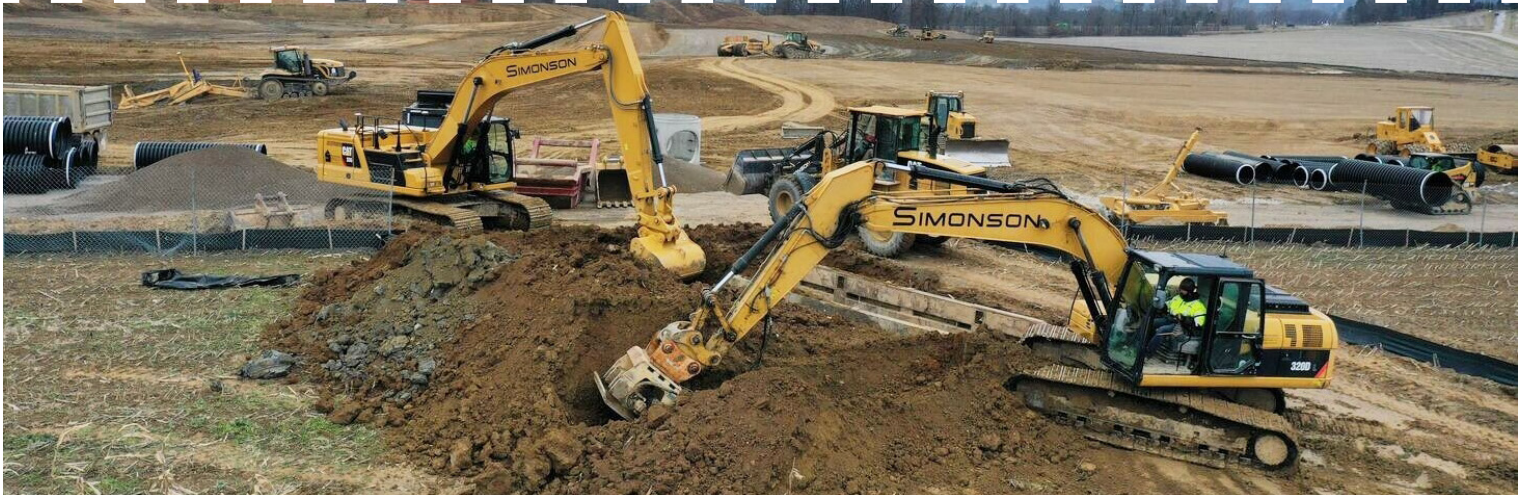

- Strong Knowledge of construction processes, design, cost reporting and cash flow management.
- Proficiency in construction-related software, project management tools, and scheduling.
